

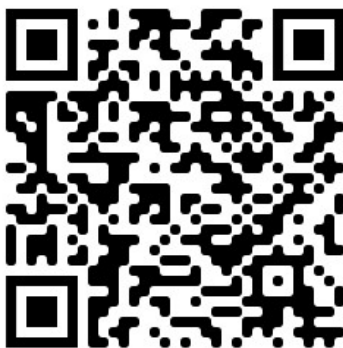

Oceania & Australian Championship Georges River 2023 – Boat Measurement

Measurement will be carried out in the rigging grounds at Georges River Sailing Club. Please come to the Measurement Station in the park sometime in the hour which you have booked [Here](#) for your measurement.

If you haven't made a measurement appointment or you miss your selected time the measurers may fit you in once everyone who has a correct booking is served.

The measurer will accompany you back to your boat and will check and tick off listed items and stamp the blades, spars, and sail which you will use.

At this event we will share dollies so you will need to present with a functioning sound dolly capable of transporting an ILCA dinghy over sand.

Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 (Safety Audit) 4.01.3 requires that the sail number be displayed on the transom in 50mm numerals. This requirement will be checked by the measurers. Tape and pens will be available at the measurement station to assist sailors to comply with this safety regulation.

Once the measurement checks are completed you will need to sign an acknowledgement that you will not change any equipment without permission of the Race Committee or the Measurer and that you will not use electronic devices capable of more than displaying time or direction while racing. You are then good to go.
